【第3問題】

How many times do you sleep at night? Most people will answer, “Once, of course. ⁽¹⁾We need to sleep for about eight hours and wake up in the morning to stay healthy.” If you wake up in the middle of the night, you may worry about *whether you can fall asleep again. But don’t worry. Sleeping twice in one night may not be a problem.

A scientist who was studying sleep did an experiment in the 1990s. ⁽²⁾In this experiment, a group of people were asked to stay in a dark room for 14 hours every day for a month. About three weeks later, he found that the people slept for four hours at first, woke up for one or two hours, and then slept for four hours again. He said that humans may originally have a *sleep pattern that *is divided into first and second sleeps. Another scientist said that there are more than 500 *descriptions of this sleep pattern in many old books. ①This means [] past.

What did the people do when they woke up in the middle of the night? According to the study, people did various things. For example, some people got up to go to the bathroom. Some people read books. And others even visited their neighbors at midnight! After an hour or two of activity, they went back to sleep.

This sleep pattern may *be related to *bedtime. Before there was electricity, people were afraid of the night. ⁽³⁾They could only work during the day and sleep early at night. People fell asleep very early, so they sometimes woke up in the middle of the night.

However, thanks to electricity, people today can do ⁽⁴⁾various activities at night. In cities, there are a lot of lights, and ②[] the stars in the night sky. If we want to eat something, we can go and buy some food at convenience stores. A lot of professional sports games are held at stadiums at night. There are even 24-hour restaurants, so we can enjoy meals until late at night. There isn’t much difference between day and night anymore.

*Developments in lighting made streets and towns brighter than before. A lot of people began to work or do activities until late at night. They also started to go to bed later than before. As a result, the time people spent sleeping decreased, and they started to sleep only for several hours at night.
